Which also means we'll need to wait for which option classes will be available next school year. • There are currently 24 students registered for the 2024/2025 kindergarten. • The Breakfast Club serves 200 kids every morning and needs more parent volunteers. Currently only 1 parent has been running the entire program with help from school staff. Volunteers are needed every morning 7:50am – 8:15am. If anyone is interested in helping, please contact the office. • A survey went out to all grade 8 and 9 students and their parents about what they wanted for their farewell celebration. Lots of students but not many parents participated in the survey. Admin will share the results with the students and keep discussing other details. Once everything has been decided on, parents will be updated. • Admin is potentially looking into cell phone lockers in every Jr. High classroom. Phone usage in the classroom has been a major issue this year. There have also been issues with students taking videos/pictures without the other person's consent. Parents are welcome to give suggestion to admin on who to approach this difficult situation, this is just a potential solution not official. • LAIR and positive behaviour program has been going very well.
