Living the Langdon LAIR life

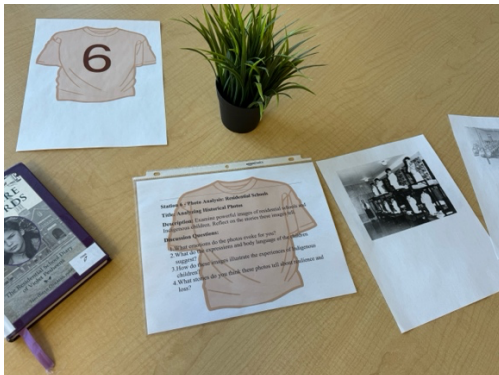
Hello Langdon school families,
