Good turn out.</li> <li>Admin is currently interviewing for 2 teaching positions, grade 2 and 5.</li> <li>Something new that's happening at Langdon school; students are now expected to line up quietly and calmly outside every morning, and every break. This has reduced aggressive behaviour among the students while entering the school.</li> <li>The NO cell phone rule has been going really well. Overall, the jr. high students have not been bringing their phones in to the classrooms.</li> <li>The Terry Fox run is this Friday. The school could use more volunteers.</li> </ul>	

b. Personal Mobile Devices and Social Media Procedure	<ul> <li>Currently, some students in the elementary grades were using their personal devices during break times.
