Daily Health Check

Parent/guardians are required to complete the Daily Health checklist with your child each morning **before** leaving the house for the bus or school. The protocol is to be completed at home for each child. This is a required responsibility for all parents to assess health **prior to arrival** at school. Safety for all!

Students will be required to wear masks (grades 4-9) as they enter/exit the building, move in the halls, and while in common areas, bathrooms and in classes where distancing is not feasible. When students enter each day or after breaks/recess break/lunch, they will need to wash and/or sanitize their hands.

Declaring Student Learning Method

Given the current transition many Rocky View Schools (RVS) families are experiencing with the shift to temporary at-home online learning, we are extending the deadline for families to decide if they will change their child's learning method (in-school or online). Parent Drop-off and Pick-up

Parents, thanks for your cooperation in the parent loop drop off. We appreciate you dropping your children and moving out of the loop, easing traffic congestion.

PLEASE NOTE: There is no drop off or pick up permitted in the staff parking lot or the bus loop.

Playground Hours

A little clarification... During the school day, 8:00- 3:30, the grounds and play park are for school use. We welcome public use after 3:30. Please remember, pets are **not** permitted on school grounds between 8:00-3:30, for the safety of people and pets.

Lates

It is important that students arrive at school at their designated time for entry. We realize there are unforeseen circumstances that occasionally result in a child being late for school. If your child arrives at school after the last wave of students have entered, please direct them to the main doors where a supervisor will meet them and bring them into the school to ensure our attendance is accurate and they are accounted for.

Meeting with Staff

Parents are a vital part in the education of their children. As such, there are times when it is beneficial for parents and teachers or other staff members to meet. Please continue meetings virtually as arranged by staff members or parents. Any face to face meeting may occur with the prearranged permission of the principal. All face to face meetings will take place after students have left for the day.

Item Drop Off

Forgotten lunches? Shoes? Homework? On occasion, parents need to drop off items for their child during the school day. We will have a cart at the front entrance where you can leave items that are clearly marked with the child's first and last name. We will ensure they are delivered to the child as soon as we are able.

Infirmary

Students who display any symptoms of illness will be referred to the office and the infirmary. Should the symptoms be consistent with Covid-19, the parents will be contacted, and they will be required to come and collect the child within 1 hour. Staff helping these students will be wearing proper protective equipment to ensure their safety and the safety of others.

Appointments

There may be times when you need to pick up your child during instructional time. In the past, parents have come into the school to sign-out their children. This is no longer possible. If your child needs to leave for an appointment during the day, please email the teacher and copy our secretary (langdon@rockyview.ab.ca). We will do our best to have your child ready to go when you arrive at the main doors for pick up. If you do not feel comfortable entering the school with a mask on, please feel free to call the office 403-936-4579 when you arrive, we will have your child sent out to meet you. Students may return to the school through the front entry after appointments in order to maintain learning, where time permits.
