Respected additional modular units for the upcoming year; No new announcement about new schools from Alberta Education so we asked for several new modular units and to relocate 8 units; most of the requests are for Airdrie

Losing Prince of Peace School will be closing as the building was sold; students will need to be moved to other schools; will go through public consultation process; our ward will not be impacted by this closure; will make a decision May 13, 2021 in a Public Board meeting

Funding Profile 238.5 million in 2020-21; 239.8 million for 2021-22; based on a number of factors; pleased to see funding was not reduced; held off on the new funding profile for a couple of years

Have written the Minister of Health relating to accountability, assurance and transparency regarding decision affection mental health and wellbeing; advocating for school staff to receive vaccinations to school;
