Langdon School AGM

- 1) Adjustments to school fees approved for the 2023/2024 school year. The Board recognizes increased cost pressures impacting our families. Proposed fees have been carefully considered and only minimal increases have been implemented when necessary due to rising costs of activities, products and services.
- 2) There has been a calendar adjustment required to accommodate for Provincial Achievement Tests and Diploma Exams in 2024 – please check January and February calendars for changes.
- 3) Community use fees will remain at current levels. A new fee for artificial turf field use has been added. The fee schedule is available online on the [RVS website](#). New groups may have to pay a one time insurance cost if they do not have their own insurance.
- 4) New Education Plan approved by the Board – May 25th, 2023. Please go on to RVS to read through the Goals, Outcomes and Measures. The Plan features new goals, outcomes and updated performance measures and builds on the strength of the previous plan and builds on the community engagement provided to us over the last year. - 5) Langdon Accommodation – Delegations shared their thoughts on the new Langdon Junior/Senior High School proposed Accommodation plan on May 25th. Six delegations came forward to present to the Board. May 25th is the date RVSEngage closed to the public. The Board will now review all feedback received through the various engagement opportunities. Once it has been determined who will attend the school and the grade configuration, the Board will give the School a new name.
- 6) After receiving information from administration at its May 25 meeting, the Board referred the proposed 2023/24 Operating Budget back to the Budget Committee for further discussion. After discussion at Budget Committee, the budget will come back to a public Board meeting for consideration. This will happen at the Board meeting on June 1, 2023
- 7) RVS is asking for clarification regarding comments made for school construction funding from a candidate in the Cochrane-Airdrie riding. A media release was done to clarify information for our stakeholders.
- 8) Congratulation to all RVS graduates! Over 1900 students will be graduating this year from our schools. Chestermere High School's Graduation is June 24th, 2023. Three ceremonies are held in the gym to accommodate all students and their families. 10:00, 12:00 and 2:00
